### **Safety barrier renewal on A64 Malton Bypass**

A-one+ will be carrying out essential maintenance work on the A64 Malton Bypass between Musley Bank and Brambling Fields, on behalf of Highways England.

#### **What are we doing?**

We will be replacing sections of safety barriers to maintain and improve safety. We will also renew some road signs and cut back vegetation.

We will carry out work on:

- the central reservation at Braygate Overbridge
- the east and westbound verge at Middlecave Footbridge
- the eastbound verge at Pickering exit slip road
- the westbound verge at Pickering Interchange
- the central reservation at Brambling Fields
- the eastbound verge at Scagglethorpe Culvert

Our teams will move along the road as we work.

#### **Why are we doing this work now?**

We'll be doing several projects on the A64 this year, many of which are vital for road safety. We've planned our work to minimise disruption as much as possible, but with so much vital work to complete we can't avoid working during the summer. We appreciate that there will be some short-term delays because of our roadworks, but this project will make journeys safer in the long term.

#### **What's happening and when?**

We plan to start work on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2021 and expect to finish work by the end of September 2021.

Work will be carried out during the day where possible. Where necessary, work may take place overnight between 8pm to 6am.

We'll try to finish the noisiest work before 11pm to minimise noise disruption as much as we can. We apologise in advance for any inconvenience.

### **Closures, restrictions and diversions**

To safely complete this work, we will need to close both sides of the A64 Malton Bypass (between Musley Bank and Brambling Fields) on two consecutive nights. This will allow us time to set up and remove temporary safety barriers so we can work safely.

During the week of Monday 2 August 2021, we will close the eastbound carriageway for one night. We will close the westbound carriageway the night after. A fully signed diversion will be in place which has been agreed with the local authority and police.

Following the two closures there will be 24/7 lane closures in place and a 50mph enforced speed limit to ensure the safety of customers and our workforce. Laybys will also be closed.

As we move along the road there will be further road closures to change and remove the traffic management. The dates for these closures will be announced on advance signage along the route and on social media.
