CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The Show is open to Flaxton residents only. (Students presently living away from home may enter).
2. All entries should be your own personal work or produce.
3. Only one entry per person per class please.
4. Entry fees: adults 50p per class, children's entries are free.
5. Maximum number of entries per person - 12
6. 18 and 19 year olds may enter any of the adult classes if they prefer but not the same category in the teenage section.
7. Entry forms are to be sent to Liz at Westfield House (opposite the Village Hall).
8. All entry forms must be received by 5.00 pm Saturday 29th August – one week in advance of the show to Liz at Westfield House.
9. Staging of entries on the day at the Village Hall, between 9.30 am and 11.00, accompanied by the full amount of fees (correct money please!).
10. All entries must be paid for before exhibits are staged.
11. All exhibitors must leave the hall by 11.30 am at the latest for judging to commence.
12. No person except the judges or other authorised persons shall be allowed inside the hall during judging.
13. No entries should have been exhibited at last year's show.
14. We accept no responsibility for any loss or damage to entries.
15. The judges' decisions are final.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- Photos should be unframed and ideally card mounted.
- All baked goods should be covered with clingfilm or alternative.
- Jam/chutney/marmalade should be in glass jars with new lids. Simply labelled. No fancy covers.
- Fruit and vegetables should be of uniform size.
- Leave the blush on fruit, do not polish. Place apples upside down.
- Victoria Sponge should have jam and buttercream filling.
- Any type of yeast based free form bread e.g. Focaccia, cottage loaf. Should be labelled.
- Any art, craft, yarn or embroidery item should have been made in the last year. Embroidery unframed.
